## Revelation 5 ( **World English Bible** )

<sup>1</sup> I saw, in the right hand of him who sat on the throne, a book written inside and outside, sealed shut with seven seals. <sup>2</sup> I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the book, and to break its seals?" <sup>3</sup> No one in heaven above, or on the earth, or under the earth, was able to open the book, or to look in it. <sup>4</sup> And I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open the book, or to look in it. <sup>5</sup> **One of the elders said to me, "Don't weep. Behold, the Lion who is of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome; he who opens the book and its seven seals."** (emphasis added) <sup>6</sup> I saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, having seven horns, and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth. <sup>7</sup> Then he came, and he took it out of the right hand of him who sat on the throne. <sup>8</sup> Now when he had taken the book, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each one having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.

<sup>9</sup> **They sang a new song, saying,  
"You are worthy to take the book,  
and to open its seals:  
for you were killed,**

and bought us for God with your blood,  
out of every tribe, language, people, and nation,  
<sup>10</sup> and made us kings and priests to our God,  
and we will reign on earth.” (emphasis added)
